After a very successful debut in 2023, the Welland Hope Floats Challenge is back and we are thoroughly excited that you have decided to join us again! Fundraising Opportunities

This event is a fundraiser for both the local BCS team (SNCC Hope Floats), as well as Wellspring Niagara, a not-for-profit organization that exists to provide programming for those who are currently battling cancer, along with their families and support networks. Wellspring receives no external financial or government support, and they rely completely on events such as this to operate their programs in the Niagara Region. Ready to help out? Location & Parking

This event takes places at the Welland International Flatwater Centre, located at 16 Townline Tunnel Road in Welland, Ontario. There is free on-site parking, however, we do encourage you to carpool as much as possible. All events over the course of the weekend will take place at this location, unless otherwise marked.











Rules of Racing

For 2024, we will be following two different levels of Rules of Racing. Please see the details below:

For teams that ARE using this as a Dragon Boat Canada Qualifier, you will follow Division I Rules of Racing:

- Women's teams must race with an entirely female-identifying crew, including the steersperson and drummer.
- Mixed teams must race with a minimum of 8 and a maximum of 10 of each gender.
- All racers (including the drummer and steer) must be Breast Cancer Survivors in the BCS Division.
- Roster checks will be completed in marshalling before the first race.

For teams that ARE NOT using this as a Dragon Boat Canada Qualifier, you will follow Division III Rules of Racing:

- All teams may use a steersperson of any gender. Your drummer must be a female in the Women's Division and a cancer survivor in the BCS Division.
- Mixed teams may have 1-19 female paddlers and 1-10 male paddlers. A Cancer/Supporter crew must be made up of at least 50% cancer survivors, and a BCS crew must be made up entirely of BCS paddlers.
- All team members (including the drummer and steer) are required to wear a PFD at this event. Inflatables are permitted. We will have PFD's and paddles available for all to use.

Schedule & Race Format

We currently have 36 crews registered to participate in this event, and we anticipate more to come!

All teams will race 1 x 200m, 2 x 500m, and a 2000m* final. While our goal is to have all teams participate in the 2000m race, in the case that the single day schedule does not allow us to accommodate all teams, we may make the decision to limit participation based on overall results from the straight races. As we wait for team registration to close, we anticipate a full day of racing, from approximately 8:00am - 5:00pm. Exact schedule and details to follow later in August.

Rosters & Waivers

All members of your team are required to complete a waiver prior to participating in this event. Your team has the option of completing this process online or in paper format and you will receive details on how to complete this process no later than July 10th. Waivers must be complete by Thursday, August 8th, 2024.

For teams using this as a qualifier, roster checks will be completed in marshalling prior to the first set of races. Details to come regarding identification and/or Dragon Boat Canada badges. Stay tuned!
